## How Steppin' Up Supports Survivors and Educates Youth in Sullivan County:

**\$250**

Buys new curricula and materials for youth-based prevention education programs.

**\$500**

Brings eight sessions of The Healthy Relationships Project to local schools.

**\$1000**

Trains six new volunteers to cover the crisis and support line and ensure we are available to survivors in need 24/7.

**\$1500**

Operates the 24-hour crisis and support line for three months.

**\$2500**


Funds an eight-week support group for up to ten adult survivors.


Assists the agency with providing prevention education and supports survivors of domestic and sexual violence in our community.
